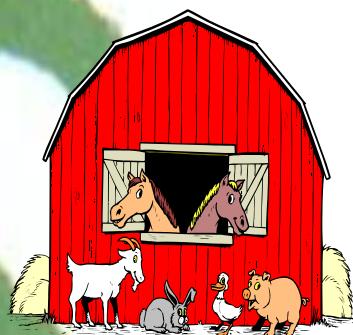


Hello and welcome to Highfields Happy Hens. My name is Beryl Hosking and I will be organising your visit for you. We have a number of enthusiastic staff members dedicated to making your visit special, all of whom have ample experience working with children of all ages.

For many years, Highfields Farm has been a refuge and a place for young people with learning disabilities, this makes it a very special and unique farm. We aim to make School visits a very fun but real, hands on experience for children of all ages, no two trips are the same, as farm life differs from day to day!

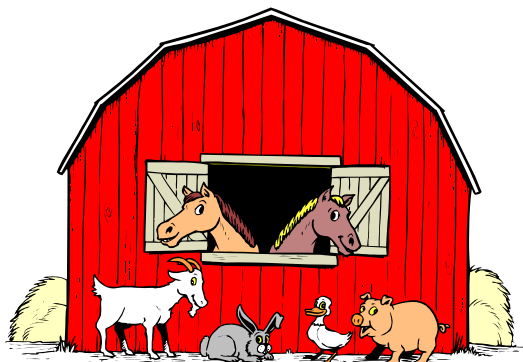


Our school visits are catered around your children and can be adapted for different topics, which you may be studying. Most areas of both key stages 1 and 2 can be included, as the children become involved in the different activities on the farm. The actual farm tour lasts around one and a half to two hours, although your trip can last all day. We have a great deal of space for your own individual activities (such as games and/or walking around the farm at your own pace).

Trips are charged from £4.50 per person and include the use of our function room for meal/picnic, work area, etc; a tractor and trailer ride around the farm, egg collecting and visiting whatever is happening on that day (eggs hatching, chicks, lambs etc) all of which is within your tour. You may also use the picnic areas, the nature trail, the bouncy castle and the fields (for games). Sandwich boxes can also be provided for your trip at an extra cost (please see following information). We do not take bookings for less than 10 children, this enables us to cover costs. If your group is less than this, we would need to ask for the full price of 10.



The farm is open Monday to Saturday 10am-5pm and trips are available throughout the week. All group visits **must** be pre-booked. Teachers are welcome to a free tour of the farm to help them plan the day, this must also be pre-booked to ensure that I am available.



What is there to do?

School visits to Highfields Happy Hens provide an enjoyable time for adults and children alike. From just £4.50 per person we provide you with an experience that will never be forgotten! This price now includes the use of our function room containing tables and chairs. There is plenty of room for a meal or picnic (sandwich boxes can be provided by us at an extra cost) and could also be used as a work area for you if you were planning to do any activities whilst on the farm. The room can also be used for other functions such as fun days, a work area, alpha away days etc.

We have a policy to help with your costs, this is, for every five children attending the trip, one adult can accompany them free of charge. All other adults must be paid for at the regular cost of £4.50 per person (optional extra's, such as, eggs to take home, sandwich boxes, etc are not included within this policy).

The basic package consists of a trip around the farm and includes the following:

- ❖ Tractor and trailer rides.
- ❖ A guided tour of the farm.
- ❖ Egg collecting.
- ❖ Animal feeding.
- ❖ Use of our function room

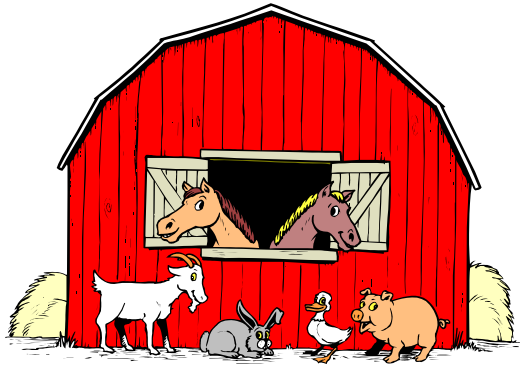
A visit to Highfields Happy Hens can be as long or as short as you want it to. If you would like to spend more time on the farm, there are many more activities that can fill your day, these include:

- ❖ We have a parachute, which you are welcome to use (at an extra cost)

- ❑ And many more...

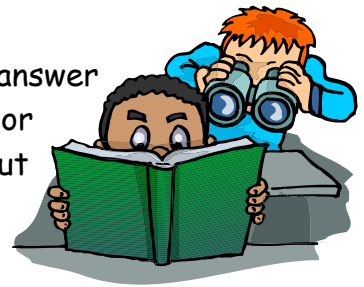
Throughout the tour of Highfields, the children will gain a great deal of hands on experience, taking part in farm activities such as,

- ❑ Holding and petting animals
- ❑ Animal feeding
- ❑ Egg collecting

This will help to encourage the children to explore many areas of the national curriculum, without them even knowing it!!

English.

There is ample opportunity for children of all abilities to ask and answer questions, there are also a great deal of information signs for us, or the children to read, this will help them to gather more facts about the farm and about the different animals. Younger children may also enjoy singing animal songs as they explore the farm.



Maths.

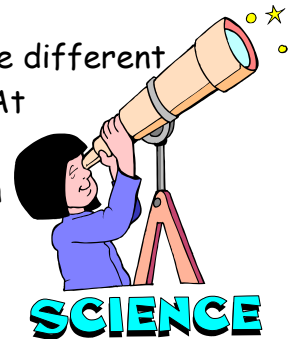


The opportunity for exploring mathematics within your farm tour is endless, with counting eggs and animals, and estimating which egg is heavier or lighter. There is also great opportunity to explore shape and size.

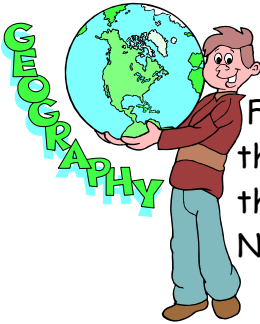
For the older children, they could estimate, and measure the area of different fields and or barns around the farm.

Science.

With most farm animals growing to be different sizes and having quite different life cycles, there are many ways in which science can be encouraged. At Highfields, our main aim is to teach the children where their food comes from, and how it is produced, this can lead to a great impact on each child's scientific knowledge.



Our Nature Trail also provides a great opportunity for scientific conversation, with pond dipping. Also information and findings of other wild animals etc.



Geography.

Farm land provides endless leadings to geography. There are so many things that the children can explore within the farming environment, that it could be quite difficult to choose which area to study. The Nature Trail is usually great fun for this.

Art.

If you are choosing to spend the day at Highfields Happy Hens, you may get an opportunity to allow the children to sit and draw a picture of a certain animal, machine or simply an area of the farm. If there is not enough time for this, you could encourage the children to take some photos which they can then draw back at school.



We are also looking into providing creative sessions as an extra for primary school visits, this will include basic creative ideas, such as, painting, drawing, collage etc, which will be based on their farm experience. (If you are interested in this, please phone for more details).



History.

History can also be discussed whilst on your visit to Highfields, children could find out about the farming day/year, or they could simply compare how farming has changed over the years, including, the farm land itself, the animals and the machines.

Technology.

Farms can sometimes be quite dangerous places, the children can look, and take part in all of the health and safety aspects which we have around Highfields. There are also many different machines which are used around the farm, these can be discussed and models can even be made back at school.





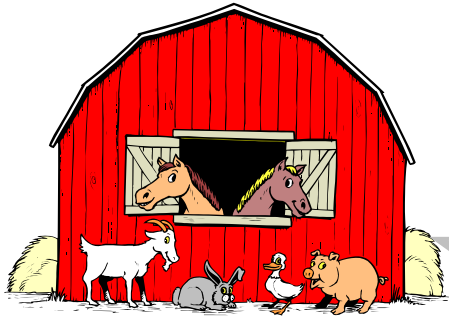
Religious Education.

Highfields Happy Hens can encourage discussion about different celebrations and festivals, such as Easter and Harvest Festival. You could also discuss the different foods from different religions.

There are endless games, experiments and activities, which can be carried out either on the farm or back in the classroom. We have produced a book of learning activities (some of which is work sheets that can be copied), which is linked directly to your visit to Highfields Happy Hens. This book is priced at £12.50 and offers a range of activity ideas, both for on the farm and back in the classroom, it is linked in with key stages 1 and 2. We recommend that you purchase this book before your farm visit in order to plan ahead!

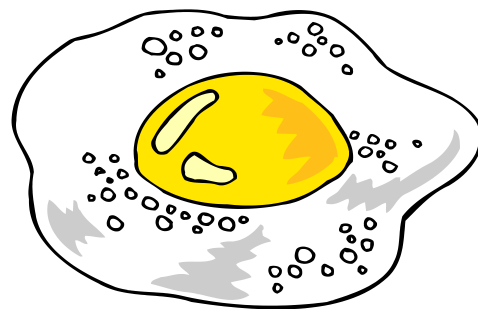
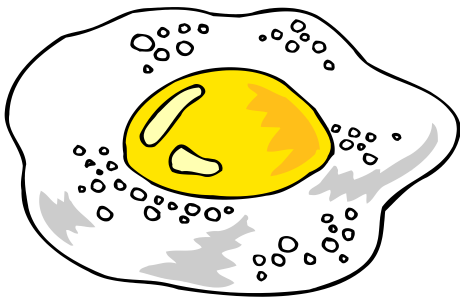


Eggs To Take Home!

For an extra 75p per child, they can take $\frac{1}{2}$ doz eggs home, which they have collected themselves. This provides each child with a great treat, which they can be proud of.

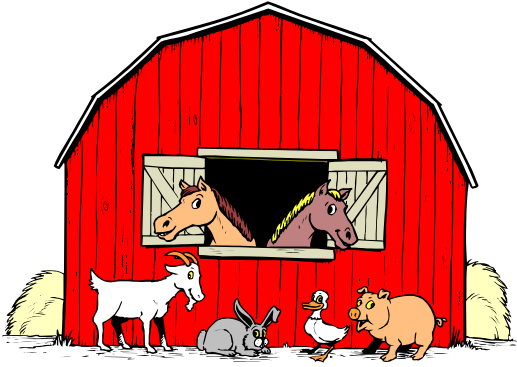
All of the eggs that the children are buying will be stamped with the name of your school, this is just a little extra something that the kids will love.

Each child will be given a small box in which to put their six eggs, their names are then put onto each one, making sure the correct eggs go home with each child. The boxes are then given out at the end of the trip (to prevent too many omelettes!).

A Fruit Yogurt

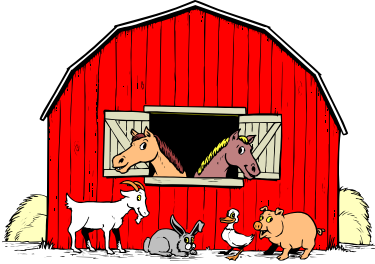

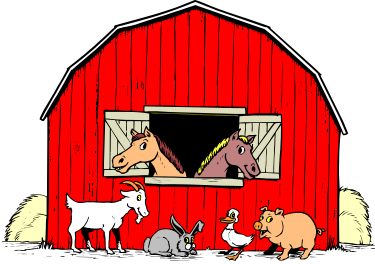

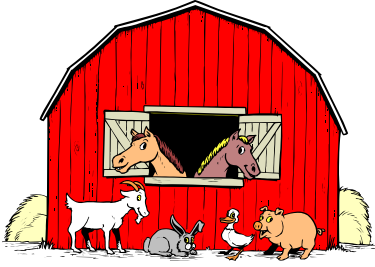

Parachute!

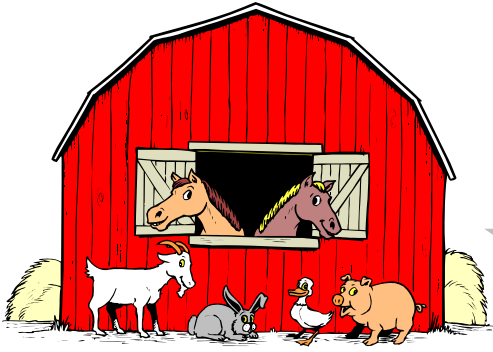
Our 3.5metre parachute is very popular with children of all ages and provides endless fun!

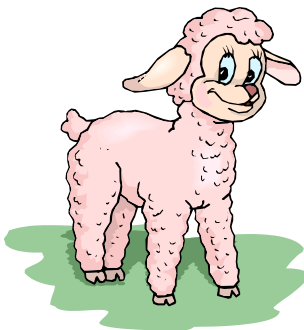
